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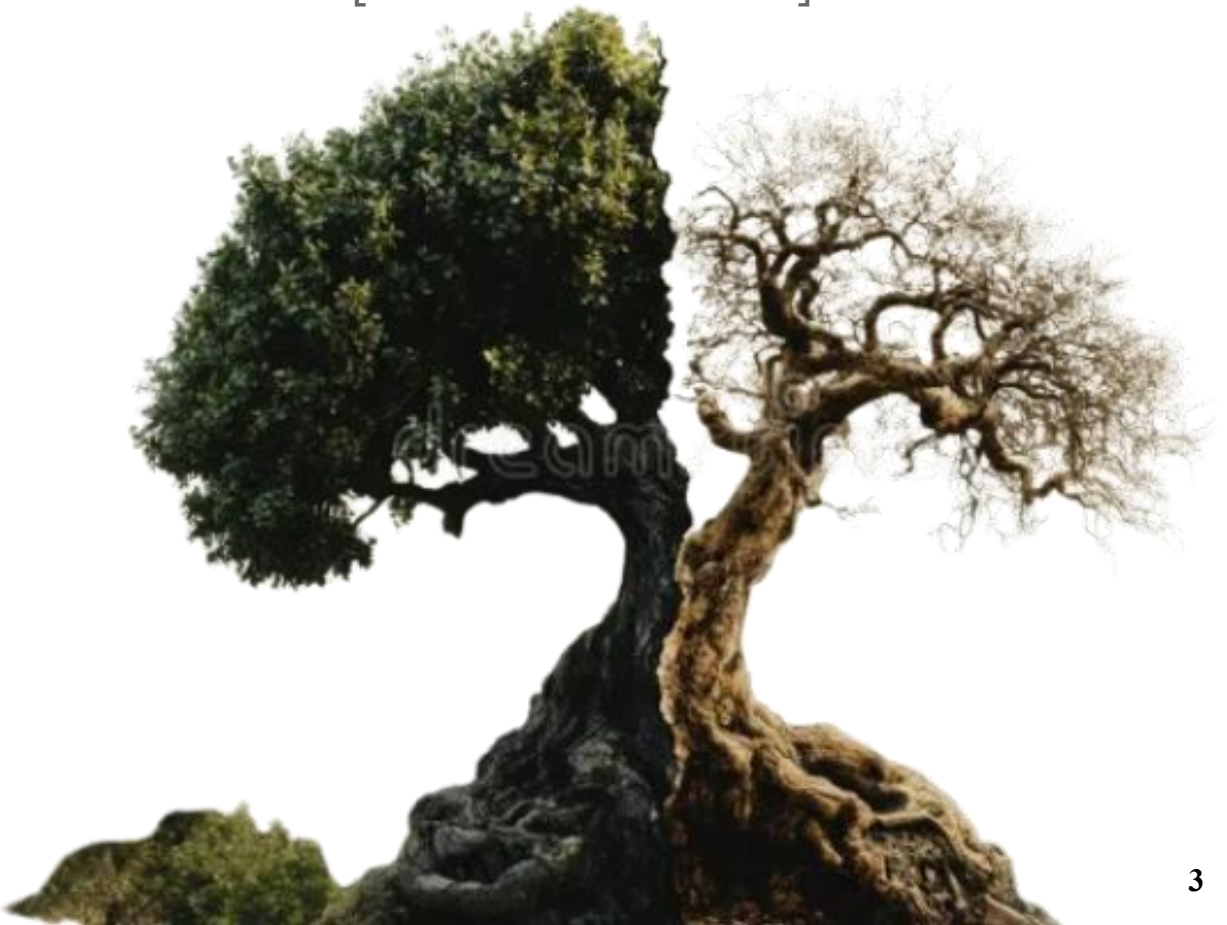


What Is The Current State Of Your Heart?

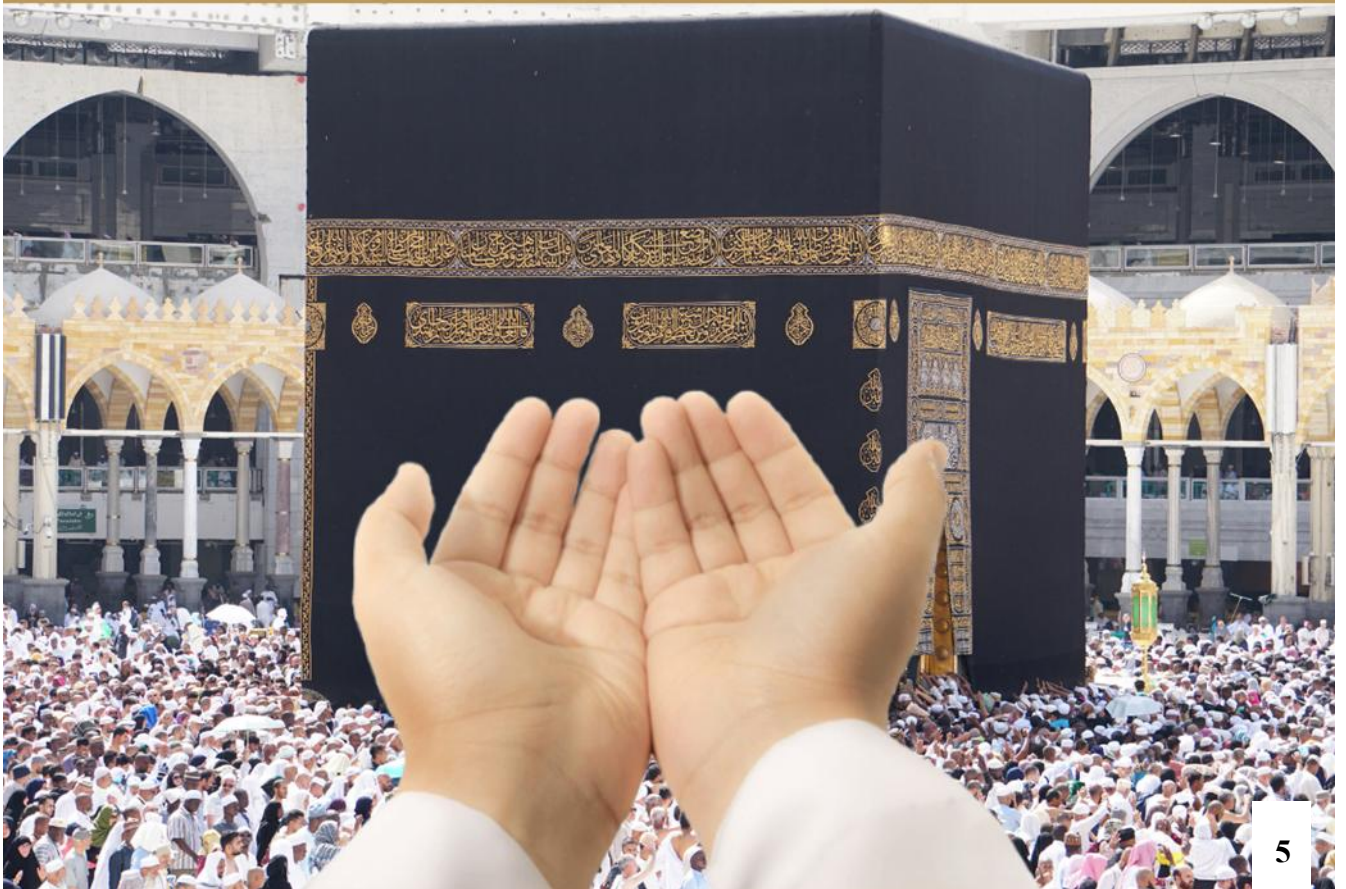
Foreword

Dhul Hijjah is one of the four sacred months chosen by Allah (The Most High) that hold immense rewards, particularly the first ten days of Dhul-Hijjah, where Day of Arafah and Eid al-Adha are inclusive of these blessed days. Hajj is a reflective moment of reflection and renewal, and amongst the righteous actions are fasting, praying, recite the Quran, give Sadaqah and remembering Allah (The Most High) through Dhikr, and making supplications (Dua).

Dua is a personal prayer and communication between you and Allah and is amongst the core actions of worship. There are many reasons why people make dua, it may for themselves, their families and wider community and the world as a whole.

This book aims to provide a series of supplications during the season of Hajj (pilgrimage) to create, build, and make a connection with Allah (The Most High). An opportunity to seek forgiveness for our previous sins and incorporating His essence, attributes and actions.

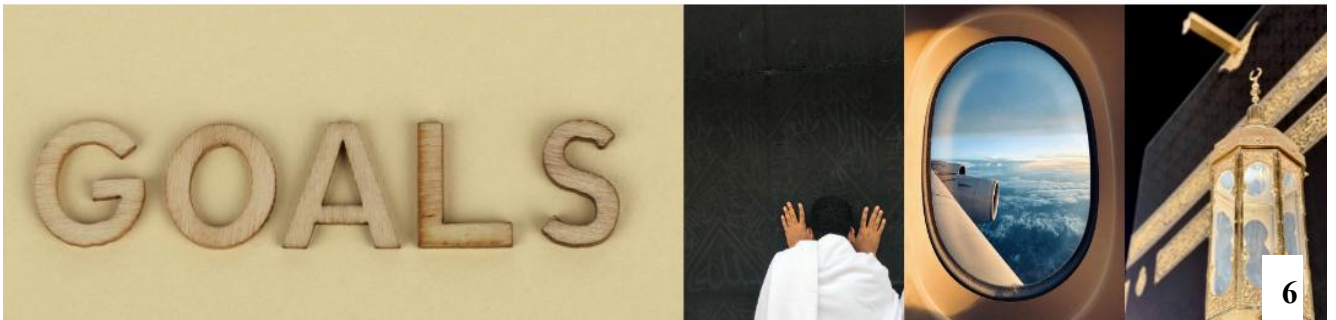

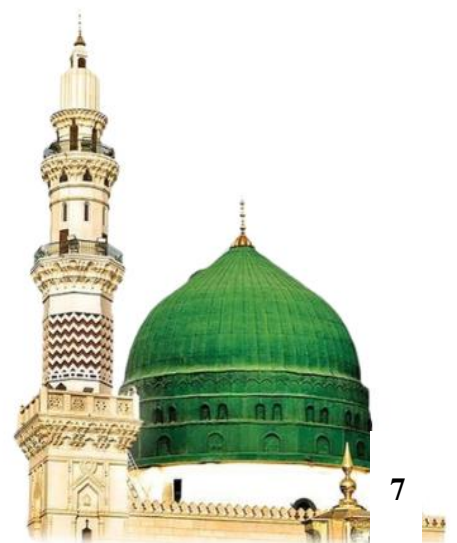


'Abdullah ibn 'Umar (may Allah be pleased with him and his father) reported:

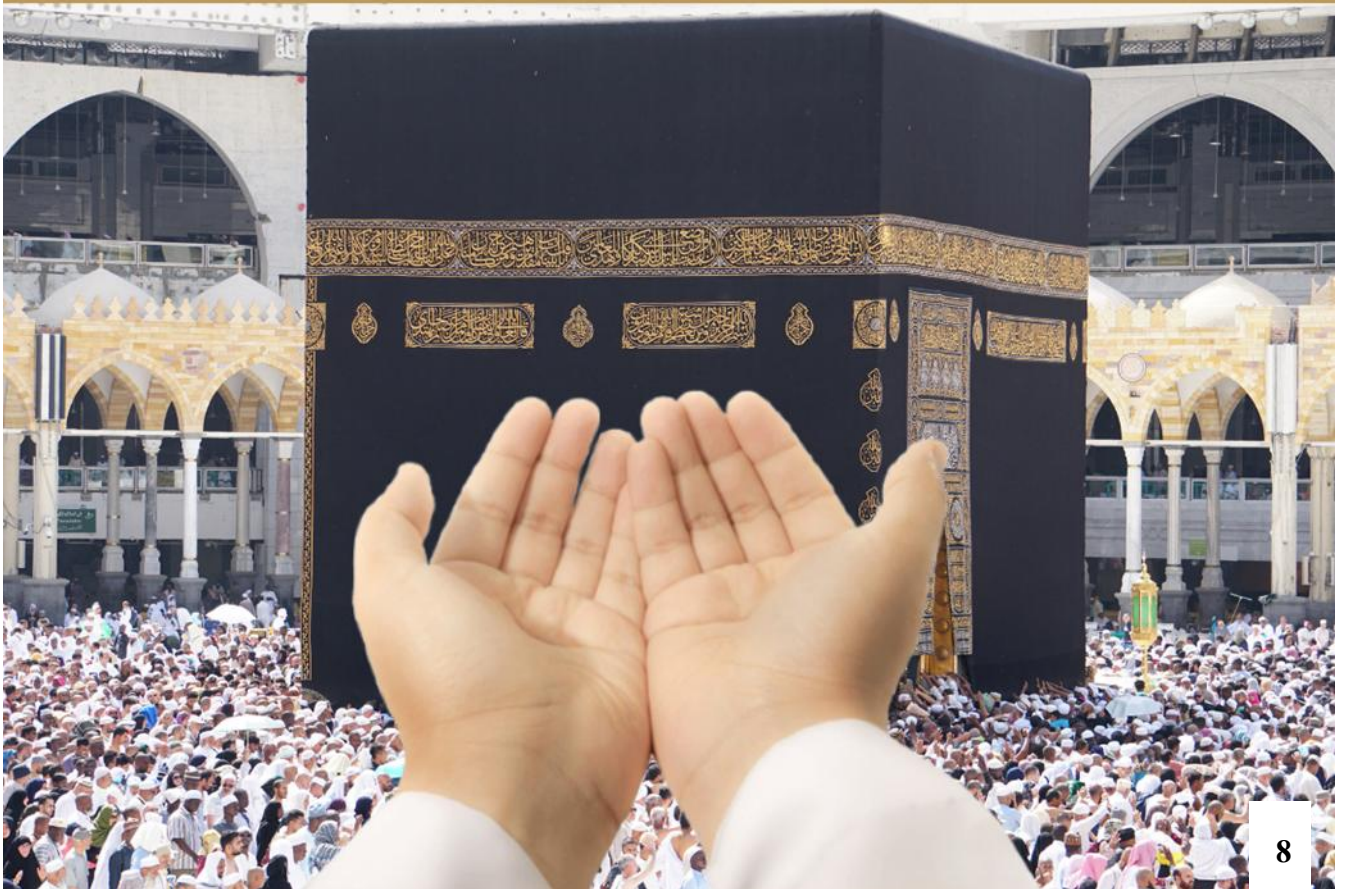

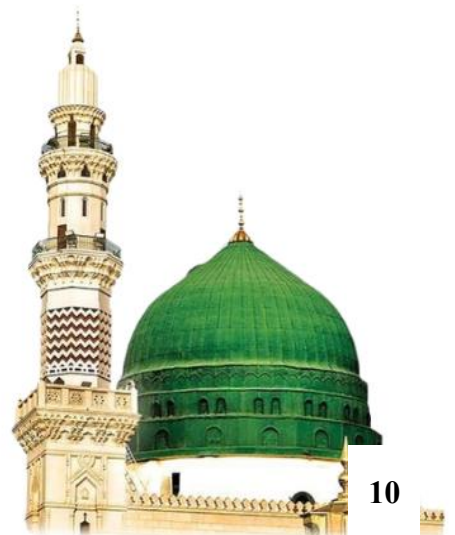
The following is a special Dua to recite on the Day of Arafah. The best time to make Dua is during the last hour before Maghrib prayer.

Abu Ayyub Al-Ansari (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:

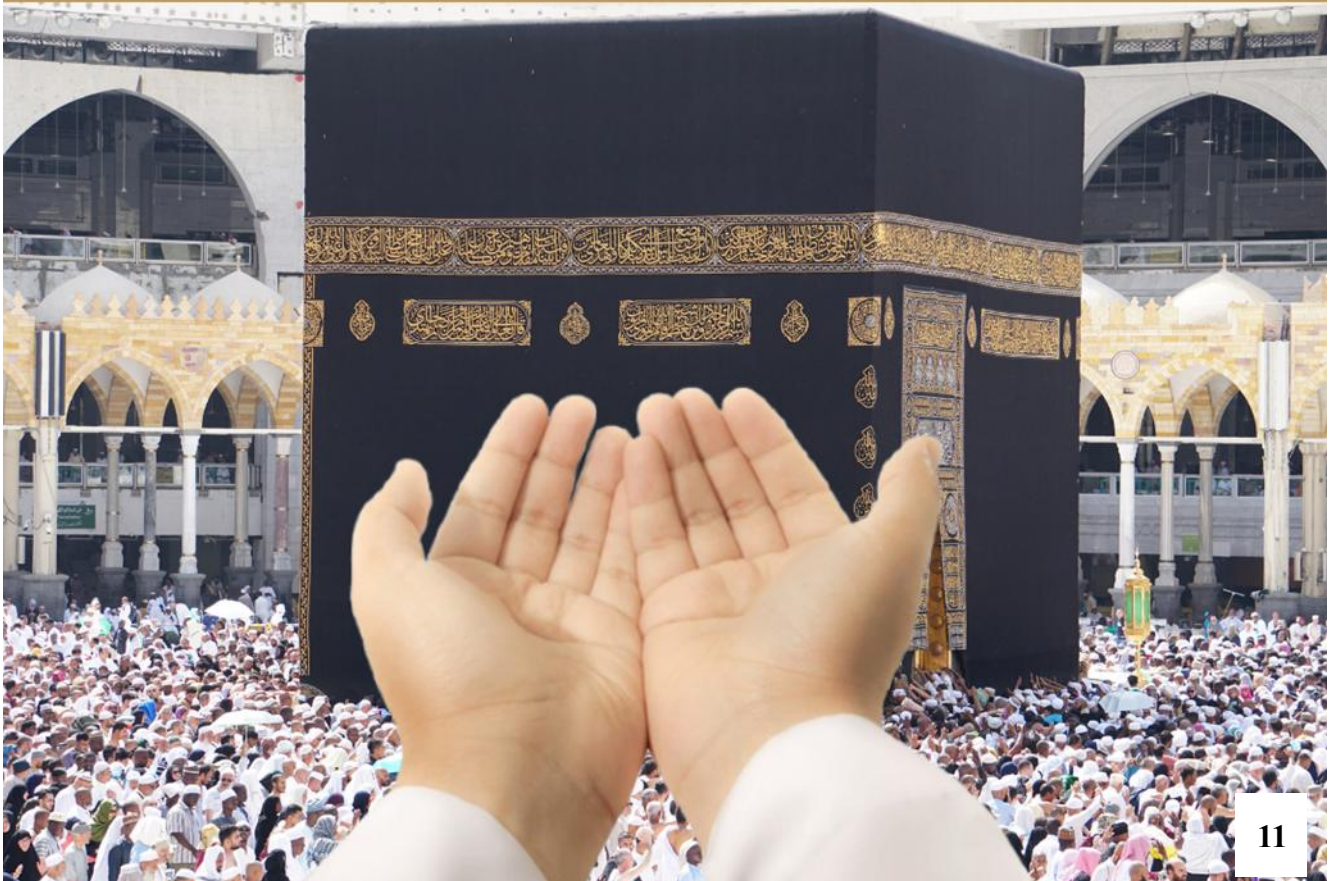
The Prophet (peace be upon him) said:

"He who utters ten times: 'La ilaha ill Allahu, wahdahu la sharika lahu, lahulmulku wa lahulhamdu, wa Huwa 'ala kulli sha'in Qadir (There is no true god except Allah. He is One and He has no partner with Him. His is the sovereignty and His is the praise, and He is Omnipotent),' He will have a reward equal to that for freeing four slaves from the progeny of Prophet Isma'il."

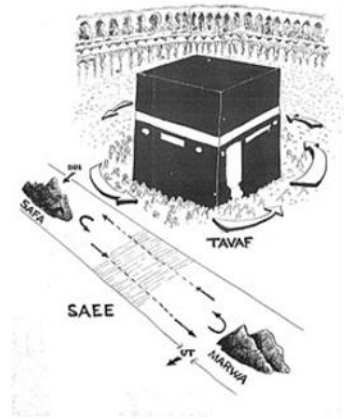

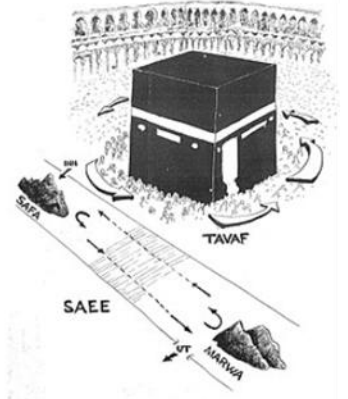

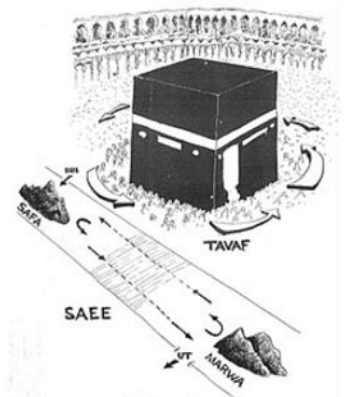

Sa'ee

Whenever the Prophet (peace be upon him) approached Mount Safa, he would recite: ***Innas-ṣafā wa 'l-Marwata min sha`ā'irillāh. Abda'u bimā bada'allāhu bih.*** He began (his Sa`y) at Mount Safa climbing it, until he could see the House. He then faced the Qiblah repeating the words: ***Lā ilaha illallah, Allahu Akbar*** Then he said: ***La ilaha 'illallah wahdahu lā sharika lah. Lahu 'l-mulku wa lahu al-ḥamd wa huwa`alā kulli shay'in Qadir. la 'ilaha illallahu wahdahu, anjaza wa`dahu, wa nasara `abdahu, wa hazama 'l 'ahzāba wahdah.*** Then he would ask Allah for what he liked, repeating the same three times. He did at Mount Marwah as he did at Mount Safa.

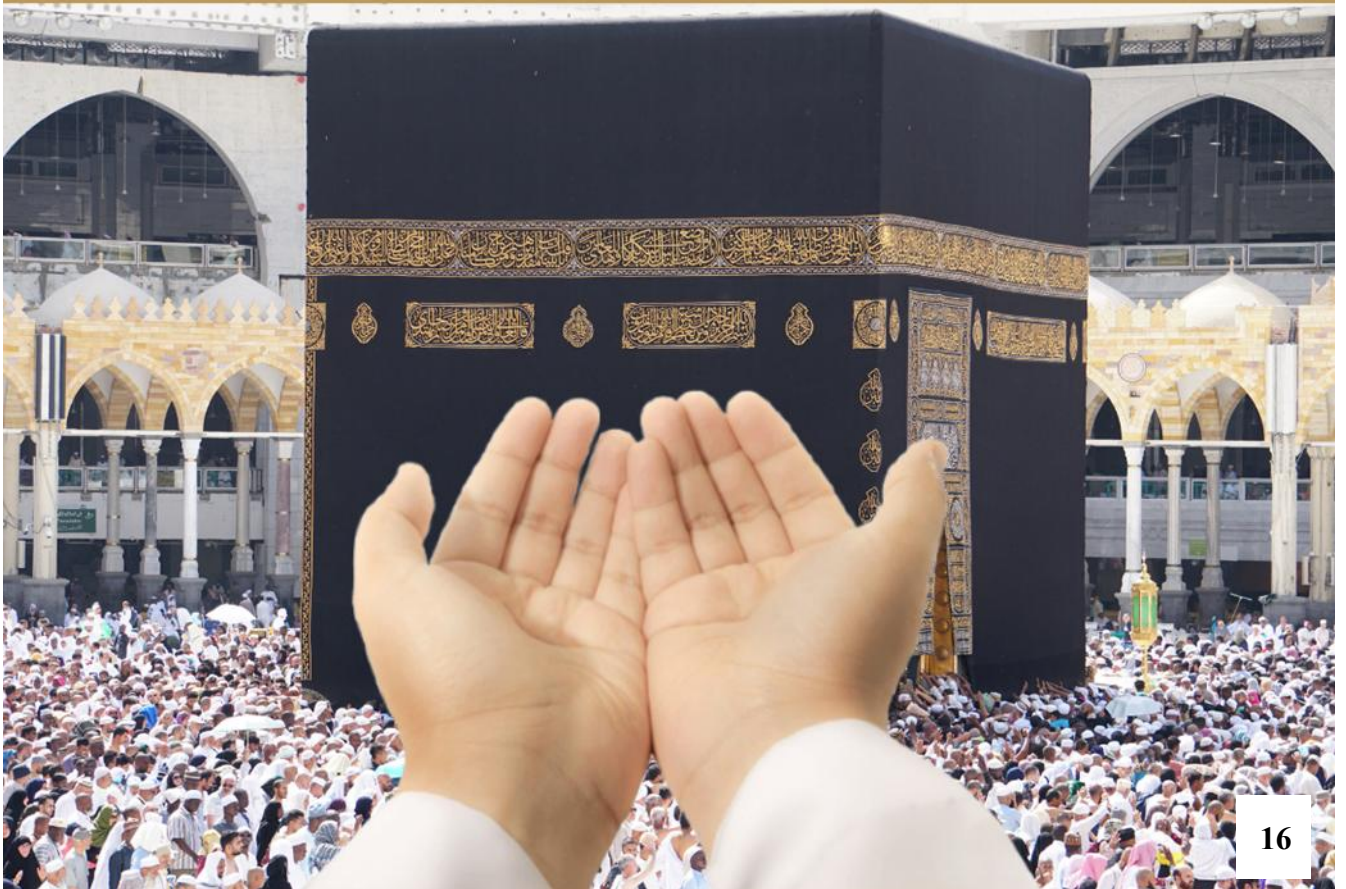
English Translation

Whenever the Prophet (peace be upon him) approached Mount Safa, he would recite: ***Surely Safa and Marwah are among the signs of Allah. I begin by that which Allah began.*** He began (his Sa'y) at Mount Safa climbing it until he could see the House. He then faced the Qiblah repeating the words: ***There is none worthy of worship but Allah, and Allah is the Most Great.*** Then he said: ***None has the right to be worshipped but Allah alone, Who has no partner, His is the dominion and His is the praise, and He is Able to do all things. None has the right to be worshipped but Allah alone, He fulfilled His Promise, He aided His slave, and He alone defeated Confederates. Then he would ask Allah for what he liked, repeating the same thing like this three times. He did at Mount Marwah as he did at Mount Safa.***

Al-Agharr Abu Muslim (may Allah have mercy upon him) narrated that he bears witness from Abu Sa'eed Al-Khudri and Abu Hurairah, that they bear witness that :

The Prophet (peace be upon him) said: ***“Whoever says: ‘There is none worthy of worship except Allah, and Allah is the Greatest, (La ilaha illallah, wa Allahu akbar)’*** His Lord affirms his statement and says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except Me, and I am the Greatest,’*** and when he say: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except for Allah, Alone, (Lā ilāha illallāh, waḥdahu)’*** Allah says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except for Me and I am Alone.’*** And when he say: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except for Allah, Alone, without partner, (Lā ilāha illallāh, waḥdahu lā sharīka lahu)’*** Allah says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except Me, Alone, I have no partner.’*** And when he say: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except for Allah, to Him belongs all that exists, and to Him is the praise, (Lā ilāha illallāh, lahu-lmulku wa lahu-hamdu)’*** Allah says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except Me, to Me belongs all that exists, and to Me is the praise.’*** And when he says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except Allah, and there is no might or power except by Allah, (Lā ilāha illallāh, wa lā ḥawla wa lā quwwata illā billāh)’*** Allah says: ***‘There is none worthy of worship except Me, and there is no might or power except by Me.’”***

And he used to say: ***“Whoever says it in his illness, then dies, the Fire shall not consume him.”***

Praise be to Allah, Who has fed us from food, and given us drink, and clothed us from nakedness, and guided us from misguidance, and made us see from blindness, and has favored many of those whom He created with a great favor. Praise be to Allah, the Lord of the worlds."

When the Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, would lie down on his side for sleep, he would say,

“All praise is due to Allah, who has sufficed me, protected me, fed me, and given me drink, who has been favorable to me and who has given to me lavishly. All praise is due to Allah in every circumstance. O Allah, Lord of all things, their Sovereign, and God of all things, I seek refuge in You from the Hellfire.”

Abū Saʿīd al-Khudri (may Allah have mercy upon him) narrated that when the Messenger of Allah (peace be upon him) said:

“Allah listens to him who praises Him,” he also said: O Allah, our Lord, to thee be the praise in all heavens. Mu’ammil said(in his version);

“In all the heavens, and in all the earth, and in all that it pleases Thee to create afterwards. O thou Who art worthy of praise and glory, most worthy of what a servant says, and we are all thy servants, no one can withhold what thou givest or give what Thou withholdest. “The narrators then were agreed on the words: “And riches cannot avail a wealthy person with Thee.”

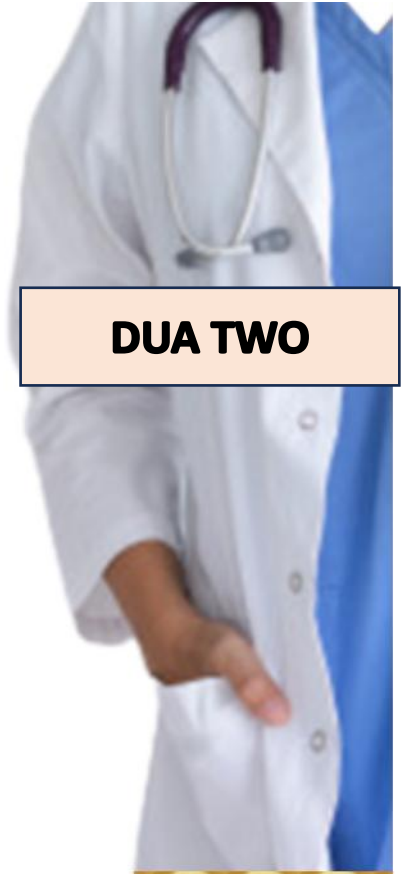
The Prophet (peace be upon him) used to treat some of his wives by passing his right hand over the place of ailment and used to say,

"O Allah, the Lord of the people! Remove the trouble and heal the patient, for You are the Healer. No healing is of any avail but Yours; healing that will leave behind no ailment."

Uthman bin. Abu al-'As Al-Thaqafi (may Allah have mercy upon him) reported that he made a complaint of pain to Allah's Messenger (peace be upon him) that he felt in his body at the time he had become Muslim. Thereupon Allah's Messenger (peace be upon him) said:

Place your hand at the place where you feel pain in your body and say Bismillah (in the name of Allah) three times and seven times A'udhu billahi wa qudratihi min sharri ma ajidu wa uhadhiru (I seek refuge with Allah and with His Power from the evil that I find and that I fear).

Place right hand on place of pain.

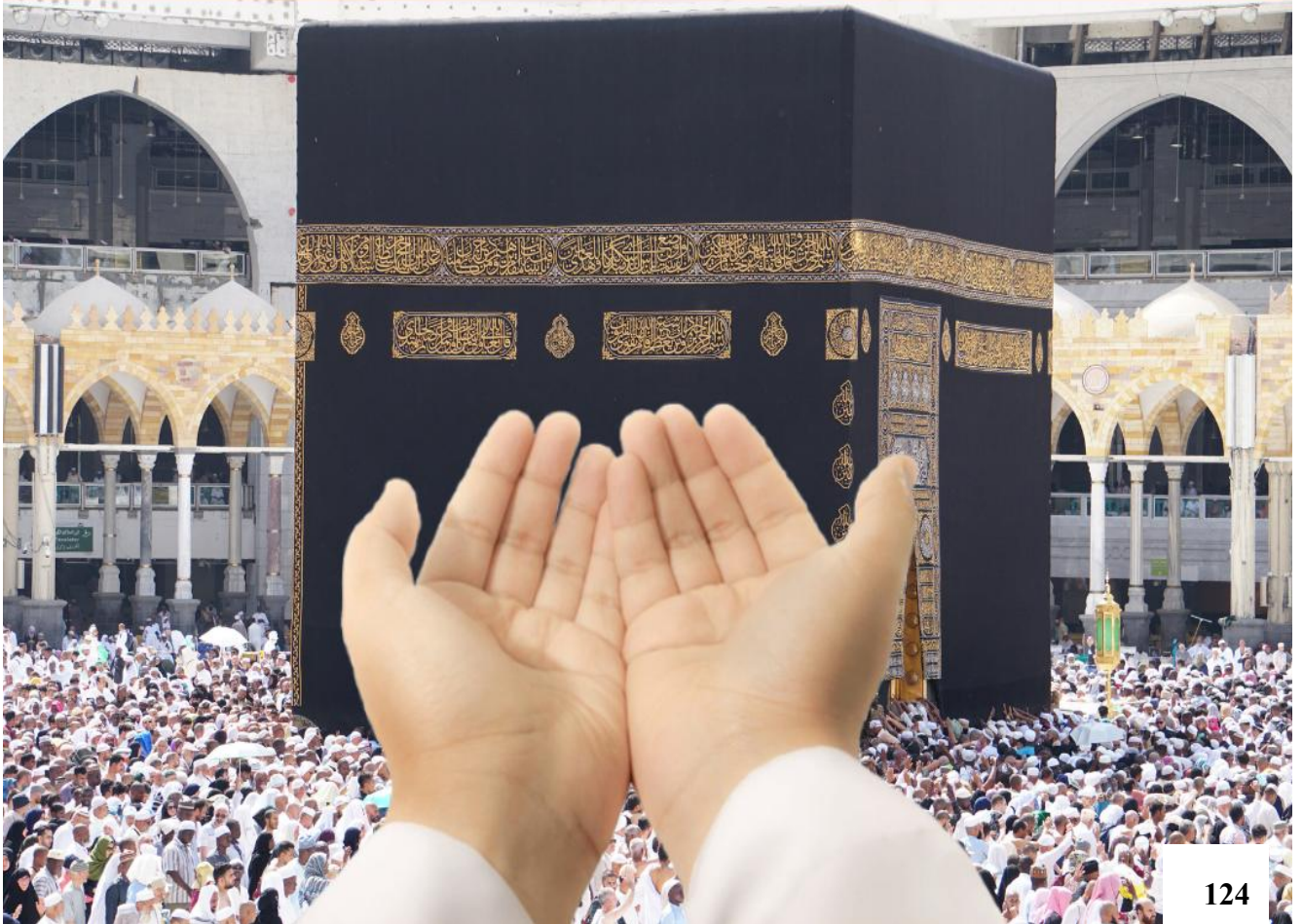
The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to say when breaking his fast:

It is recommended for every Muslim adult to recite the Takbeer-e-Tashreeq after Fardh prayer from the 9th-13th Dhul Hijjah. Men should recite this out loud, while women should recite this silently:

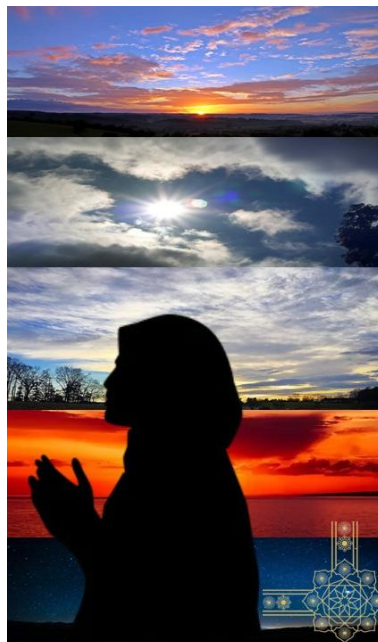

Eid Ul Adha

Mu'sab bin Sa'd (may Allah have mercy upon him) reported on the authority of his father that a desert Arab came to Allah's Messenger (peace be upon him) and said to him:

Teach me the words which I should (often) utter. He said: Utter,

"There is no god but Allah, the One, having no partner with Him. Allah is the Greatest of the great and all praise is due to Him. Exalted is Allah (He is free from imperfection), the Lord of the worlds, there is no Might and Power but that of Allah, the All-Powerful and the Wise."

He (that desert Arab) said:

These all (glorify) my Lord. But what about me? Thereupon he (the Holy Prophet) said: You should say:

" O Allah, grant me pardon, have mercy upon me, direct me to righteousness and provide me sustenance." Musa (one of the narrators) said: I think he also said:" Grant me safety."

But I cannot say for certain whether he said this or not. Ibn Abi Shaiba has not made a mention of the words of Musa in his narration.
